All candidates considered must be licensed by DPOR. NSP is authorized under the Housing and Recovery Act of 2008. NSP funds will be targeted to neighborhoods that demonstrate a significant need and the ability to significantly impact and stabilize the project area. In light of the mission of this Federal Program, reduced fees and commissions for services may apply.

Interested parties for the position of Appraiser must submit the following information:

- A resume of experience and education
- A copy of current DPOR license
- A written statement of how the Grantee's project will be incorporated into the applicant's current workload.
- A comprehensive statement of the applicant's experience with foreclosed properties over the last two years
- And a list of no less than five of references in such related work.
